#### **Weatherization Readiness**

Weatherization Readiness Funds allow the Weatherization program to address deferral conditions and bring dwellings into a Weatherization Ready state so weatherization work can begin on the home. The majority of approved jobs in North Dakota have been roofing related like re-shingling. Since October 2022, in North Dakota, there have been:

#### The Affordable Connectivity Program

The Affordable Connectivity Program is an FCC benefit program that helps ensure that households can afford the broadband they need for work, school, healthcare and more. The benefit provides a discount of up to \$30 per month toward internet service for eligible households and up to \$75 per month for households on qualifying Tribal lands. Community Action Agencies in North Dakota have been spreading awareness of the program and assisting households with applying for the benefit since August 2023.
